### **Applications are due Mid–November 2025 (for Summer 2026 Departures)**

The Japan Exchange and Teaching (JET) Programme is a Japanese government sponsored exchange programme that offers university graduates opportunities to work in Japan as either an **Assistant Language Teacher (ALT)** team teaching with a Japanese Teacher of English in elementary, junior and senior high schools or a **Coordinator for International Relations (CIR—fluency in Japanese is an asset)** in selected local government offices in Japan.

#### **Basic Requirements:**

- Canadian citizenship
- Bachelor's degree (in any field)
- Excellent English language skills

#### **Why the JET Programme?**

- Flexible contract, 1 year renewable contract up to 5 years
- Adequate salary (First Year: ¥4,020,000)
- Free round-trip airfare to Japan
- Accommodation assistance and affordable rent
- Medical, dental and pension plan coverage
- Accident and employment insurance
- Free orientation and training seminars and Japanese classes
- Placements throughout Japan
- Paid leave (including national holidays)
